

Game Varieties

Glenroy Hunting Safaris offers hunters a wide range of trophy hunts - Red Stag, Fallow Deer, Wapiti, White Tail Deer, Chamois, Himalayan Tahr, Wild Goat and Arapawa Ram and American Bison almost covering the whole spectrum of New Zealand game. An added attraction is complimentary small game, such as hare, rabbit and opossums, while there is excellent fishing for Rainbow and Brown Trout in nearby rivers, Lake Hayes and Lake Wakatipu.







Hunting Season

Our hunting season is from March to July.

The recommended average hunt duration is five full days plus day of arrival and day of departure. Of course hunters can add a few days for sightseeing. We are situated in the middle of the scenic circle of New Zealand.

Millbrook
